TOILET CREDIT PROGRAM

Program Requirements

- Customer is solely responsible for purchase of toilet installation arrangements and payment.
- COG does not warrant, endorse, or assume liability for the quality, performance, or safety of any plumber or contractor, its employees, or agents related to purchase under this program.
- Credit certification form must be returned to the COG by the expiration date to be valid.
- Customer agrees not to alter the toilets and/or showerheads in order to increase the flow of water through the fixtures.
- Customer agrees that credit(s) will be through credit(s) on his/her water bill. Your credit should show up on your water bill one to two billing cycles after it is processed.
- Customer agrees that old toilet(s) and showerhead(s) will be disabled and removed by the plumber/contractor.
- Customer agrees that plumber/contractor may refuse to replace toilet if customer does not agree to pay for improvements that are necessary for proper functioning of toilet.
- Customer agrees that plumber/contractor can refuse to replace showerheads in cases where plumbing is old or unstable.
- Customer agrees to allow COG inspector access to verify installation if selected for random inspection.
